- Each Restricted Stock Unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of Isis common stock, or its equivalent cash value.
- Restricted Stock Unit Award granted on July 1, 2014. Restricted Stock Units vest in equal annual installments, the first installment vested on July 1, 2015. Upon vesting, the restricted stock units will be paid out in whole shares of Isis common stock or cash as may be determined by the Company. The RSU shall be fully vested on July 1, 2018.
- Grant of July 1, 2015 to reporting person of Restricted Stock Unit Award under the Isis Pharmaceuticals, Inc. Amended and Restated 2002 Non-Employee Directors' Stock Option Plan. Restricted Stock Units vest in four equal annual installments, the first installment vesting on July 1, 2016. Upon vesting, the restricted stock units will be paid out in whole shares of Isis common stock or cash as may be determined by the Company. The RSU shall be fully vested on July 1, 2019. The RSU is vested as to 0 shares on July 1, 2015.
- Grant of 7/1/2015 to reporting person of stock options under the Isis Pharmaceuticals, Inc. Amended & Restated 2002 Non-Employee Directors' Stock Option Plan. The option vests and becomes exercisable in four equal annual installments, the first installment vesting on 7/1/2016. The option shall be fully vested and exercisable on 7/1/2019. The stock option was exercisable as to 0 shares on 7/1/2015.
